## Class Report 2019

The total number of active boats in Denmark in 2019 are 15, where 2 new teams has started and 1 disappear. We still see crews are prioritizing the J70 class with possibility of winning the champions league. The boats are based around 70/30 in Copenhagen and the mainland.

The Danish National championship was held in Vallensbæk, Copenhagen 23.-25. August 2019 with a great fleet of 20 boats from Denmark, Sweden, Norway and Germany. Total 13 Danish teams. The Danish championship was won by Team DEN 782, Kim Christensen.

Only 3 Danish teams were represented to the worlds in Italy this october.

Next year we will balance the national race calendar against the European league calendar, and the Nordic countries race calendars as well to ensure that the teams have the possibility to participant is many races as possible

The 2019 Danish championship will be placed 7.-9. August 2019 in Halmstad sweden, to ensure more boats. We will in the Norway, Denmark and Sweden coordinate races together to ensure more boats for the regattas.
