

Report of the Austrian *Melges24* Class Association 2022

2022 was the first “normal” season after two years of Covid related restrictions for watersports and travelling.

In May Segelclub Kammersee at Attersee hosted the Melges 24 Austrian Championships with 11 boats from Germany and Austria on the starting line. After 6 races the podium has seen 1. AUT503 (Michael Luschan and team), 2. GER677 (Luis Tarabochia and team) and 3. AUT716 (Michael Schineis and team).

During summer several Austrian teams were competing in regattas at Lake Garda.

In the European Championships in Genua our fleet was represented by AUT503 (Michael Luschan and his team).

Today we have 9 boats in the Austrian fleet.

Our biggest concern today is the availability of essential spare parts like masts and spreaders. If this will continue even in the next months this will lead to significant damages for our members and our class.
