During this period the weather conditions are expected to be about 12/15 knots from the west or east.


We have organized in 2022, the J70 European Championship (in September also).

Our structure operates year-round and organizes all our projects and activities.

Our club is open every day except Sunday when there are no regattas.

THE FUNCTIONS OF OUR ADMINISTRATIVE POLE ARE MULTIPLE

Welcoming our members, our trainees, taking FFVoile licenses, setting up our regatta organizations, administrative management of the club...



THE ADMINISTRATIVE FACILITIES provided by the city of Hyères

1SECRETARIAT + 1 COMPUTER ROOM (RESULTS) + 1 MEETING ROOM + 1 STORAGE ROOM.

They are located on the 1st floor of the Espace Nautique, at 14, avenue du Docteur Robin. We are equipped with high performance computer means.

The nautical pole is in charge of the organization of our sailing schools, sports and competitions, and the organization of the nautical part of the regattas that we set up.

TECHNICAL FACILITIES at your disposal

1WORKSHOP+1LARGE STORAGE ROOM+2 SMALL ROOMS

They are located in the building of the municipal nautical base, in front of our administrative buildings. The parking lot of the nautical base allows to store about a hundred dinghies or catamarans. It is entirely fenced.

THE LAUNCH IS 150 M LONG.

The municipal nautical base has a women's and a men's locker room, each equipped with showers (10) and toilets.

The dinghy basin opens directly onto the bay of Hyères



OUR NAUTICAL AND TECHNICALS MEANS ARE COMPOSED OF 5 SEMI-RIGID BOATS

Many volunteers equipped with speedboats join our own means.

We have a complete set of racing buoys and all the necessary equipment (VHF, GPS, flags, sound equipment,...)

They allow us to make sail many young people and teenagers, we have:

15 LASERS (LASER RADIAL & 4.7) - 10 SCHOOL OPTIMISTS - 8 COMPETITION OPTIMISTS 5 HOBIE CAT 16 - 5 HOBIE CAT DRAGOON - 1 FIRST CLASS 8.



THE RECEPTION AREA

The «ESPACE NAUTIQUE HYÉROIS» is made available by the city of Hyères for the organization of receptions. It has a large reception room that can accommodate approximately 400 PEOPLE (prize-giving ceremony), a room with approximately 100 PLACES, a restaurant room with approximately 70 PLACES and a large reception hall for registrations. These premises are equipped with a workshop for the preparation of a small kitchen and toilets. The nautical base also has 4 COURSE ROOMS that can be used for jury panels.



MEANS OF TRANSPORT

The COYCH has 1 minibus as well as many trailers for dinghies and RIBs



SAILING SCHOOL

SUMMER SAILING SCHOOL

Five consecutive half-day courses for the general public are offered from July 1st to August 31st each year. They welcome an average of 450 students per season.

These schools are held in Optimist, Hobie Cat 16, Dragoon and First Class 8. All the equipment is provided and we pay particular attention to the quality of our teaching; many trainees come back regularly. Every year the FFVoile renews its «French Sailing School» labels.

The Beach Point of l'Ayguade opened since the summer of 2013 allows the practice of windsurfing, paddle in the form of courses or rental.

WINTER SAILING SCHOOL

Our winter sailing school operates with:

- . a beginner optimist group on Wednesday morning
- . an optimist criterium group on Saturday afternoon
- an optimist competition group on wednesday afternoon and saturday afternoon
- a group HC 16 adults (12 people) and HC Dragoon teenagers on Saturday morning
- one group on First Class 8 boats on Thursday afternoon and Saturday morning.

SPORT AND COMPETITION SCHOOLS

OPTIMIS

Eight children sail every Wednesday and Saturday afternoon and compete in League, Interleague, National and International regattas. This activity is our sporting priority, the equipment provided to the young athletes belongs to the club.

ILCA7,6&4

Fifteen members sail at a high level.

Our sports school operates on Wednesdays all day long, on Saturday afternoons and goes to all the League and Mediterranean Championship regattas. A dozen young sailors train regularly, allowing the club to be ranked in division 1 Elite of the National Dinghy Ranking.

ECONOMIC IMPACT:




The merchants of the Port of Hyères, but also and above all the hoteliers of Hyères, benefit directly from the regattas of the COYCH.

East from 10 to 25 knots with nice waves
