TECHNICAL COMMITTEE REPORT

Event: Melges 24 World Championship 2025

Date: 20th – 27th September 2025

Location: Trieste, Italy

1. Overview

This report summarizes the technical inspections, repairs, and equipment control activities conducted during the Melges 24 World Championship 2025. All procedures were performed in accordance with the International Melges 24 Class Association (IM24CA) rules and measurement protocols.

2. Inspections Summary

- 18 boats full inspection.
- 6 masts were lowered for repair.
- 4 masts were broken of which 3 replaced during event.
- 272 sails were inspected and stamped.
- 3 crew changes recorded.
- 6 boats were hauled out for repairs.
- XX jib halyards replaced.
- 1 rudder strap or gudgeon repaired/replaced.
- 1 tiller broken and replaced.
- 3 spinnakers broken beyond repair, replaced.
- 42 boats on-water controls for mandatory equipment and sail checks.

3. Repairs and Equipment Control

All repairs were completed following class rules and under the supervision of the Technical Committee. On-water inspections confirmed compliance with mandatory safety equipment and sail inventory regulations.

4. Summary

The Technical Committee expresses appreciation for the cooperation of all competitors and support teams. The overall technical compliance during the championship was satisfactory, and all issues were resolved promptly.
